



K-3 Early Literacy - Cohort #1: (Five-Part Series)

Phonological Awareness, Phonics, Small Group Instruction, & Writing

High quality, explicit, systematic instruction should be a core part of your reading instruction and is absolutely essential for students who are at risk for reading difficulties.

Day 1: Phonological & Phonemic Awareness (PA) - Learn the developmental sequences of phonological and phonemic awareness, reflect on your current assessment practices and explore several diagnostic instruments for assessing phonemic awareness and learn and practice evidence-based instructional techniques.

Day 2: Phonics - Phonics is a critical building block of early literacy. Learn when and how phonics instruction should begin and how a high quality phonics lesson is developed and delivered.

Day 3: PA & Vocabulary - We will conclude our focus on phonological awareness and phonics and explore the development of student vocabulary within guided reading.

Day 4: Small Group Instruction - Continue the exploration of small group guided reading instruction with an emphasis on comprehension.

Day 5: Writing - The three types of writing: narrative, opinion and informational within the writing process/workshop framework.
