- a. Best Practices and Recommendation (revisit previous documents)
 - Lakewood does have a collaborative team meeting protocol when a student returns (usually IEP/504 students); but general education students are still returning without school's knowledge and/or transitioning without consistency
 - ii. Read article *Transitioning Students from Psychiatric Hospitalization*Back to School
 - iii. Feedback from group: No need to reinvent wheel (psychiatric transition tools can be adapted to other types of transition); importance of MOU; clarification of roles; Need point of contact in school with breadth of resources for all transition needs; page 67 Discharge Planning could be used to create a template/form or flowchart to track systems of care and steps for re-entry; existing reintegration protocols for PEP and Alternative students could be used as a starting point; upon re-entry, connect to people in building who already have positive relationship with the student
- b. Re-entry Plan checklist and Plan versus District Safety Plans
 - i. Checklists hold accountability for schools
 - ii. Identify issues of confidentiality
 - iii. What is the school's plan of action if there is a check-in protocol for student and the check-ins are not happening?
