A student is considered habitually truant if the student is absent without a legitimate excuse for 30 or more consecutive hours, **42 hours in a month** or 72 or more hours in a school year.

(Student Name) absences continue to be a serious concern and attendance has not improved. Attendance laws require North Royalton City Schools to begin a process to create an attendance intervention plan for you and your child to assist your family in improving school attendance.
