


School Mental Health Community of Practice Evaluation of September COP Experience

30% of COP members (32 out of 105) completed the September evaluation. Among the group who evaluated their September COP experience, 30% were building and district administrators, 26% were educators and classroom personnel, 18% were school counselors, 15% were social workers, and 11% were school psychologists.
