

Students Experiencing Homelessness

When you find that a student is homeless - the **first step** is to call the parent to do some research about their needs. If they are homeless then school or family needs to call Coordinated Intake:

Call 216-674-6700, press Option

#1 for young adults (18-24) or #3 for families

The **second step** is to connect the family to COHHIO...the school or family should email COHHIO to inquire about housing.

Third step - connect child to a caring adult (mentor) so they have someone to talk with.
