

I-480 becomes St. Rt.14.

Stay on Rt. 43 to St. Rt. 59 (Haymaker Parkway).

Turn left onto St. Rt. 59.

At next traffic light turn right onto South Water Street .

Turn left at first traffic light onto Summit Street.

Stay on Summit Street.

At 5th traffic light turn left onto Risman Drive.

Risman Drive curves to the left in front of the Student Center.

From the South:

I-71 / I-77 to I-76 East (Interstate map) to St. Rt. 43 North (exit 33)

Stay on St. Rt. 43 to St. Rt. 261 (less than 2 miles).

Turn right onto St. Rt. 261.

Turn left onto Campus Center Drive.

At stop sign turn left onto Campus Center Drive West.
