The <u>Ages & Stages Questionnaires</u>: <u>Social Emotional</u> (ASQ: SE) child-monitoring system was developed to take an in-depth look at the social and emotional development of children ranging in age from 3 to 66 months. This workshop will review this easy-to-use screening tool so professionals can quickly recognize young children at risk for special and emotional difficulties as soon as possible, as well as identify any need for further assessment. Please note that the Ohio Department of Education requires that the questionnaire be used by the teacher and parent(s) together.

Note: ODE-funded Early Childhood Education (ECE) programs are now required to complete the ASQ: SE for all children in the fall of each school year. Preschool Special Education programs complete the ASQ: SE for all children fall and spring of each school year. Therefore, all individuals who will be administering the ASQ: SE, if not previously trained by the State Support Team, are required to participate in an ODE approved training. A limited number of ASQ: SE assessment materials, both English and Spanish are available for Cuyahoga County School districts.
