The Spring 2015 Alternate Assessment for Students with Significant Cognitive Disabilities (AASCD) represents the third administration of the new alternate assessment design. **Returning Test Administrators (TAs) and Second Raters (SRs) are required to attend a half-day training session.** The half-day session will review key components of administration procedures, provide valuable updates, and introduce new components of the spring 2015 administration.

All **new** TAs and SRs are required to attend a full-day training session. *Note that the TA training sessions for the AASCD are separate from the extended standards training.*

Audience: AASCD Test Administrators and Second Raters ***who were trained in the administration of the AASCD.***

Registration for SST-3 events must be done through the Ohio Department of Education's registration system, STARS. SST-3 can not accept paper registrations.

A "SAFE Account" must be set up first in order to register.
