Restart Readiness Assessments, also known as Checkpoint and Benchmark Assessments, will continue to be available for district use throughout the 2023-2024 school years; the use of these assessments will be explored as valuable instructional tools.

## Data Available in CRS

- Ohio's State Tests (OSTs)
- Alternative Assessments for Students with Significant Cognitive Disabilities (AASCD)
- Restart Readiness Assessments (Benchmark & Checkpoint)
- Ohio English Language Proficiency Assessment (OELPA)

## Benefits of Checkpoint & Benchmark Assessments

- Composed of OST released items
- Individual student and item analysis data (no more GUEST USER access)
- Familiarizes students with OST platform
- Provides teacher with student/class/school/district/state comparison results
- ELA Teachers: review individual student writing responses with machine-scored results
- Checkpoint Assessments: 10 question assessments aligned to tested area reporting categories to embed within curriculum (made of OST released items)
- Benchmark Assessments: full-length practice tests mirroring OST assessment blueprint (made of OST released items)
