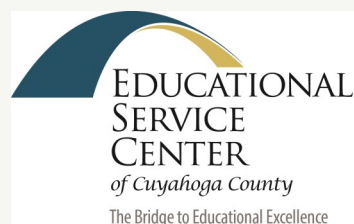
Administrators are an essential part of the success of co-teaching programs. Co-teaching involves general education
