- We will read and discuss the book, Collaboration, Coteaching, and Coaching in Gifted Education: Sharing Strategies to Support Gifted Learners by Mofield, E. & Phelps. In this online, asynchronous course, participants will explore how collaboration, coteaching, and instructional coaching can enhance gifted education services across settings. This practical guide offers frameworks, examples, and tools to support gifted learners through shared expertise. Participants will engage in weekly reading reflections and peer discussions. Those seeking graduate credit will submit a final project.
- Google Classroom will serve as the platform for submitting reading response posts, discussions, and final project submissions (graduate credit only). This course consists of 9 reading assignments from the text and 9 reading response posts that are submitted weekly. You are expected to respond to at least two posts from your classmates after posting your initial reading response. If you have purchased graduate credit, a final project is required and must be submitted by the conclusion of the course.
