Cathy Lassiter, National Author and Speaker, in partnership with a team of leading curriculum consultants from the ESC of Northeast Ohio, have designed and created this four day institute that will walk teacher teams through defining and understanding teacher clarity, share evidence-based practices, work through a progression of understanding, as well as learn how to measure for, Depth of Knowledge (DOK), analyze sample assessment tasks as well as develop an understanding of how to transform and improve student learning.

There are three main purposes to the institute:

1. Present an instructional process for achieving teacher and student clarity in the K-12 classroom
2. Build an understanding of the components necessary to engage students in their own learning in the classroom through learning intentions, success criteria and opportunities to respond and feedback
3. Engage teachers in reflective practice about their teaching by assessing their impact on student learning.
