FOR THE GENERAL EDUCATION TEACHER

The recent changes in Ohio's Gifted Operating Standards recognize the importance of regular classroom teachers working with gifted students to obtain professional development hours in gifted education. These modules address important topics necessary to ensure success for gifted students in our schools.

Facilitators of these modules all have gifted endorsements and concrete experiences with gifted students, including teaching classes, coordinating programs, and guiding students throughout their K-12 educational experiences.

Module 1—Nature and Needs of Gifted Students

August 11, 2017 *or*

October 5, 2017

This beginning module is designed as an introductory course on the characteristics and identification of students, including social and emotional needs, cognitive traits, and Ohio law and program options for serving our gifted population.

Module 2—Identification & Assessment of Gifted Students

September 12, 2017

This module enables the participant to gain a better understanding of gifted identification process, exploration of various assessments, and how this relates to Ohio law. Prerequisite—Suggested but not required, Nature and Needs of Gifted Students.

Module 3—Curriculum & Instruction for High Ability Students

November 2, 2017

This module familiarizes the participant with various strategies to enhance curriculum and instruction for gifted students, including acceleration, differentiation, and teaching for depth and complexity. Prerequisite—Suggested but not required, Nature and Needs of Gifted Students.
