- ◆ Understand the importance of daily intentional sequential lessons based on 8 phonemic awareness skills (Rhyming, Onset Fluency, Blending, Identifying Final or Medial Sounds, Segmenting, Adding Phonemes, Deleting Phonemes and Substituting Phonemes).
- ◆ Understand the methods and reinforcement movements that go with each lesson.
- ◆ Administer the PAST assessment to identify specific student phonemic awareness needs.
- ◆ Understand how to plan and deliver targeted Tier 2 interventions in phonemic awareness based on specific student needs.
