Research has shown that quality programs have a positive impact on child outcomes, school readiness and school success. What is a quality program and how does a program's vision and desires for the children they care for align with quality measures? Training participants will explore these topics, including quality environment as interaction indicators and various program assessment tools. Prerequisite: Program Improvement with Measures of Quality Overview

The Environmental Rating Scale (ERS) is a recognized tool to assess infant/toddler, preschool, school age, and family childcare environments. Training participants will learn how the ERS measures quality, become familiar with the design for accurate assessment observation, learn the scoring system, and become aware of considerations for conducting self-assessment as a measure of quality.

Measuring quality through program and classroom assessments is important for program improvement, but assessments alone do not bring about quality. Training participants will explore how to create a quality improvement plan based on assessment results and identify key factors to effective implementation for sustaining change.
