Resident Educator Mentor Academy Day 1

New mentors to the Resident Educator Program are required to successfully complete the two-day Mentor Academy Training to receive mentor certification. Day 1 focuses on the role of the mentor and the critical components of mentoring. Mentors are introduced to the essential content of mentoring to prepare them in supporting the instructional growth and development of Resident Educators.

Resident Educator Mentor Academy Day 2

New mentors to the Resident Educator Program are required to successfully complete the two-day Mentor Academy Training to receive mentor certification. Day 2 focuses on formative/summative assessment, providing feedback and observations for learning. Mentors apply knowledge and skills learned on Day 1 to design, practice and implement differentiated mentoring to support and accelerate the instructional growth and development of the Resident Educator.
