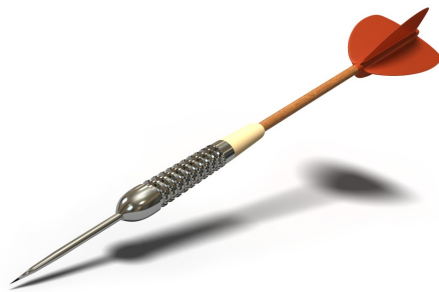


From Theory to Practice: Strategies for Deepening Your Initiatives— Modeled with MAP Growth
