

Transitioning to OTES 2.0

Evaluator Credentialing

The Bridge to Educational Excellence

The implementation of Ohio Teacher Evaluation System (OTES) 2.0 will require a new credential for those who evaluate teachers. There are two pathways towards credentialing determined by your experience with teacher evaluation. This is a blended learning online course which is primarily asynchronous and self-paced with participation in synchronous learning session required. Please review the requirements below and select the option for you.

OTES 2.0 Bridge Training

- To be eligible for OTES 2.0 Bridge
 Training, participants must have been credentialed as evaluators under OTES
 1.0. This credential need not be current.
- Participants are required to complete all asynchronous coursework within the selected 2-week window.
- Participants are required to attend ONE synchronous session (via Zoom)
- Cost: \$125

OTES 2.0 New Evaluator Training

- This option is for new evaluators who did not hold an OTES 1.0 credential
- Participants are required to complete all asynchronous coursework within the selected 2-week window.
- Participants are required to attend
 TWO synchronous session (via Zoom)
- Cost: \$170

Registration Information:

- Registration must be completed through the <u>OH|ID portal</u>, in the Training and Registration tile.
- Search "virtual" in event name.
- There will be a Bridge and a New Evaluator version for each session window; please ensure you register for your correct option.

You will be required to attend either ONE or TWO synchronous sessions selected from the choices within your session window. Sessions are approximately ½ hour.
