OMJ K-12 is the enhanced version of the former Ohio Career Information System (OCIS) and is now available FREE of charge to all Ohio students. OMJ K-12 will provide students, families, and professionals a means to develop, update, and maintain a personalized transition resource as they progress through their K-12 education to become productive adults.

This training will provide district personnel with the basic functioning of the OMJ K-12 website including registering for an account, and the use of the site to support and train students as they create, develop, and maintain their career “Backpack”. As a personalized internet Cloud resource, the Backpack will be integral in saving all the investigative efforts of students.

During this training, you will also have the opportunity to receive hands-on experience using the OMJ K-12 website portal. This training is open to intervention specialists, counselors, and general education instructors who want to provide OMJ K-12 training to their colleagues.
