## **ED**STEPS One Needs Assessment

The One Needs Assessment is a comprehensive tool that provides the opportunity for districts and schools to focus on a few items of high impact for continuous improvement. The One Needs Assessment directs districts and schools towards creating a "focused plan" One Plan. All districts and schools that receive federal funding are required to use this planning tool to develop/revise their One Plan for FY24. The **One Needs Assessment Overview Sessions** will provide a general overview of the enhancements to the One Needs Assessment and One Plan, timelines, and root cause analysis resources.
