PBIS Tier II interventions are integrated strategies and procedures to support a group of students who display similar needs and have not responded well to school-wide (Tier I) behavioral expectations. Tier II interventions are only effective when schools have a strong foundation of school-wide (Tier I) positive behavioral interventions and support (SW-PBIS). During this two day series teams will build a framework of evidence based Tier II interventions ready for implementation.

It is required that teams have evidence that PBIS Team Member(s) have attended and shared information from the PBIS Classroom Management PD with building staff; and have a minimum Tier I TFI score of 70%
