

PARAPRO ASSESSMENT TESTING

The Educational Service Center of Northeast Ohio is pleased to be offering Ohio's Online Examination for Paraprofessionals!

Who Takes the Exam? The test is for prospective and practicing paraprofessionals. Individuals should contact their school for district employment requirements for educational aides and paraprofessional working in Title 1 programs.

What is on the Test? The test consists of 90 multiple choice questions and measures the skills and knowledge in reading, writing and basic math competencies, as well as the ability to apply those skills and knowledge to assist in classroom instruction.

How is the Test Given? The test will be taken on a computer. The testing time is 2 ½ hours. Participants are encouraged to arrive 30 minutes prior to the actual test start time.

What is the Fee? The cost is a non-refundable fee of **\$80**. The fee must be paid/received no later than 5 business days before your registered test date.

Exam Time? 9:00 – 11:30 AM (participants should plan to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the exam start time)
