

Ohio School Districts and Community Schools are required to meet certain criteria on their report cards regarding the K-3 Literacy Improvement Measure.

When districts do not meet this criteria for two consecutive years, they are required to engage in creating a Reading Achievement Plan for the district or community school.

During this professional development session, participants will:

- Explore and understand the 5 big concepts of literacy.
- Use the 5 big concepts of literacy to begin to develop reading support for students by scaffolding supports for readers who are struggling
- ◆ Learn the basic components of the Reading Achievement Plan.
