Small group instruction provides focused instruction on specific student needs. Small Group: Core instruction is delivered during the daily literacy block, incorporates core instruction materials, and scaffolds students' reading. Small Group: Focused instruction is delivered through independent activities that students complete alone, with a partner, in a triad or a larger group during the daily literacy block. Small Group: Intervention is delivered in addition to the daily literacy instruction for those students who are not keeping pace with their peers—the greater the need, the smaller the group.
