This professional network is for women interested in networking with peers, discovering new knowledge, and addressing individual and personal goals.

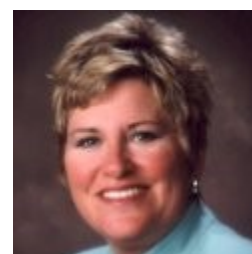
