



Intensive instruction for individuals with language-based learning disabilities

WRS Level I Certification program is designed to prepare teachers to effectively implement WRS Steps 1–6 with students who are reading and spelling below grade level, as well as those diagnosed with a language-based learning disabilities, such as dyslexia. It consists of two components: the WRS Intensive Instruction for the Non-Responsive Reader (Steps 1–6) Online Course and the Web-Based WRS Steps 1–6 Practicum.

(5) Five implementation meetings scheduled throughout the year via Zoom.

Additionally, the Wilson® Credential Trainer will observe each teacher/student pair (5) five times during the training, providing demonstrations and coaching, with written and verbal feedback.

Completion of WRS Level I Certification makes one eligible to receive the professional credential of Wilson® Dyslexia Practitioner (W.D.P.).

The Wilson Reading System® (WRS) Level I Certification is recognized as an IDA AccreditationPlus program.
