In 2007, Chrostowski founded EDWINS Leadership & Restaurant Institute with the belief that every human being, regardless of their past, has the right to a fair and equal future. His mission is to change the face of re-entry of recently incarcerated individuals in the United States. Under Chrostowski's leadership, EDWINS has grown to include culinary education and life skills at its flagship Cleveland, Ohio restaurant, Second Chance Life Skills Center, a program at Grafton Correctional Institute, and curriculum for inmates of all 30 Ohio prisons.
