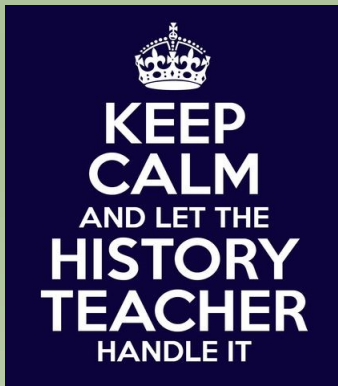
Strategies for 7th Grade World History 4/24/2018
